This patient has been referred to the Las Palmas Medical Center for a possible kidney transplant. Before the patient can be accepted as a candidate in the transplant program, as a candidate we need to ensure sure that the patient is cleared of any cardiac problems.

EVALUATION FOCUS

- Assess the cardiac risks of pre-operative morbidity and mortality
- Identify cardiac conditions that may be adversely affected by post-transplant immunosuppressive therapy (Prograf, Myfortic, Neoral, and Prednisone)
- Identify co-morbid conditions that may shorten survival and thus preclude a transplant

REQUIREMENTS

- **Basic evaluation requires:** History and physical exam **and** a Baseline echocardiogram
- **Patients over 50 years old, diabetics, or have sympyoms/history of ischemic heart disease require:**
 - A stress test
 - Echocardiogram
 - Angiogram (if necessary)
